THE FORUM

The Best Practices Forum was established in 1995 in cooperation with the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill to recognize accomplishments in the field of healthcare compliance. Since that time, the Best Practices Award has been accepted as the mark of compliance program excellence.

If you have never attended the Forum, it is unquestionably the compliance education event of the year. Unlike programs in which you are surrounded by numerous vendors, the Forum allows you to look at what others are doing successfully in their programs.

Awards are open to **any** compliance program practice provided that the practice has been implemented for at least six months. Many of the past best practices recognized at the Forum have subsequently become standard practice in healthcare compliance.

Award recipients are selected by the Health Ethics Trust Best Practices Committee, an independent committee of experienced compliance professionals.

PROGRAM DETAILS

- The first day of the Forum will run from 8:30 AM to approximately 5:00 PM.
- The second day of the Forum will run from 8:30 AM to approximately 4:00 PM.

Over the course of this annual two-day event, each Best Practice Award Winner, as selected by the Trust's Best Practices Committee of working compliance officers, will present their winning practice to those in attendance.
